The information gathered from this form will help the Principal Selection Advisory Committee on advising and recommending the skills and strengths needed for Masterman.

2. School community members can also apply to assist with the selection of the next principal of Julia R. Masterman by serving as a member of the Principal Selection Advisory Committee. This voluntary committee will provide support with the development of the leadership profile, interview questions and the participation to interview identified candidates on an identified Saturday (8AM - 5PM).
